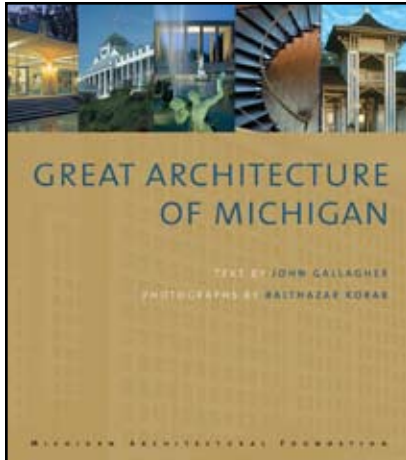

Published by the Michigan Architectural Foundation and distributed by Wayne State University Press, *Great Architecture of Michigan* showcases 150 of our state's most significant buildings in photos by award-winning photographer Balthazar Korab and text by *Detroit Free Press* architecture critic John Gallagher.

The buildings in *Great Architecture of Michigan* span the entire state and are divided into thematic sections—Buildings We Gather In, Buildings We Play In, Buildings We Govern In, Buildings for the Arts, Buildings We Learn In, Buildings We Work In, and Buildings We Live In. In addition to icons like the Grand Hotel on Mackinac Island, the Michigan State Capitol in Lansing, and the Fisher Building in Detroit, this collection includes vernacular charms like the D. H. Day Farm near Sleeping Bear Dunes, architectural survivors like the Point Betsie Lighthouse, and some thirty-five private homes. A spirited collection of churches, theaters, office towers, stadiums, and government buildings rounds out the selections.
